

Do you need a Green Card for driving in the EU?

What is a green card?

A green card is an internationally recognised proof of motor insurance cover. It must be printed on green paper. It may be needed if we leave the EU without an agreement with EU authorities

Travel before the 1st February 2020:

The possible date of the United Kingdom leaving the EU (also known as Brexit) is now set at **31st January 2020** so **you do NOT need a green card for trips concluding before this date**. As always, take a copy of your Certificate of insurance with you.

Travel after the 31st January 2020
